Text of the Law No. 40

Law of Municipality including reformed articles. The Municipality is the base Unit of the Political and Administrative division of the country. It is organized and works with citizen participation. The essential Elements of the Municipality are: The Territory, the Population and its Government. The autonomy is a Right and the effective capacity of the Municipality and the wellbeing of its Citizens. It is a principle established in the Political Constitution of the Republic of Nicaragua, that does not exempt nor does it inhibit the Executive Power or the other Estates Powers of their Obligations and Responsibilities with the Municipalities . Organic Law of the Legislative Power incorporating its Reforms. The legislative Power of the Republic of Nicaragua it is exercised by the National Assembly by delegation and mandate of the people, it is regulated by the Constitution and laws. The Organic Law of the Legislative Power aims to regulate the Organization, Functions, Powers and Procedures of the National Assembly. The Constitution and the Electoral Law determine the number of Members in the National Assembly, their Election, and related acts, duration of the position, the requirements and qualifications required the rights, powers and duties as well as the suspension and loss of the Status of member of the National Assembly. Central American Technical Regulation TCA 67.04.54:10

Annex to the Resolution No. 283-2012 (COMIECO-LXII). Processed food and beverages. Food additives. This Technical Regulation it is an adaptation of the Codex Stan Norm 192-1995. (Rev. 6-2005). General Norm of Food Additives was adopted by the Food and Beverages Subgroups and Standardization Measures of Central America. Countries Member participating by Guatemala: Ministry of Health and Welfare, for the Salvador: Ministry of Health; For Nicaragua: Ministry of Health; For Honduras: Secretary of Health; For Costa Rica: Ministry of Health. This regulation's main objective is to establish the Food Additives and their Maximum Limitations tolerable in different food categories. In the food marketed in the territory of the States Parties it will only be allowed the use of Food Additives listed in this Technical Regulation, pursuant to the provisions thereof.
